Prerequisites

There is no formal pre-requisite to attend this course, however, if you are new to agile, we recommend to first follow our Agile Fundamentals course as a lead-in.

This experiential course focusses on real-life examples and hands-on exercises to help you uncover various key concepts for implementing agile at scale. You will learn about adaptive planning techniques and a people-centric transformation approach that can help you achieve the best outcomes for your organisation.

Learning outcomes

During this course, you will learn about:

- · Visualising the flow of value to optimise the entire system
- · Designing for organisational agility
- · Empowering the organisation to deliver effective outcomes
- Aligning value to implement delivery at scale
- Sustaining continuous improvement.

Content

- Defining, visualising and optimising the system understanding the system in an
 organisational context, making sense of complexity, visualising the flow and
 prioritisation of work, and optimising the system through identifying constraints
 and delays
- Scaling agility characteristics of scaling frameworks and scaling up vs tailoring down
- Enabling change organising around value and culture change in an organisation
- Value delivery at scale defining and measuring strategic objectives, alignment of work and big room planning
- Measuring, learning and growing agile metrics and characteristics of a learning organisation.

Method used

Lecturing is kept to the minimum necessary, most of the learning is achieved through applying the practices and techniques in group exercises.

Certification

ICAgile accredited course: The ICP-DAS Certification from ICAgile is granted on the successful completion of this course. This certification is part of the ICAgile Delivery Management Track along with our Agile Fundamentals and Agile Project Management courses.

Delivery

This program is offered as a classroom-based course as well as a LiveOnline program. Our LiveOnline delivery is over three days (each four and a half hours in duration). The instructor is 100% live and interaction and learning objectives are the same as our in-person classes with the added benefit of being able to take this course from your home, your office or your home office.
